Effective Team Development with **Visual Studio 2010**

It covers tracking your changes using the new branch visualisation capability of Visual Studio 2010 as well as how to use treediff and annotate to find changes quickly and easily.

The course is well rounded out with modules on the different clients available for integrating with Team Foundation Server, how to use the Project Portal and a look at the many new compelling reports in TFS 2010.

This course includes hands-on labs to reinforce practical skills and ensure you're ready to use the tools on your return to your workplace.
